

2018 Meika Decher Clinics at Inavale Farm

January 27-28 and March 10-11

We are happy to have Meika here for two clinics this winter. She has taken three horses to the CCI *** level, ridden at Rolex, and actively competes two upper level horses in the west.



From Meika:

"I run a full eventing training facility out of Lake Stevens WA, and help everyone from young pony clubbers to adult amateurs reach their goals with their horses. Whether they are at starter level or at Intermediate level, my goal is to produce a rider who is thoughtful and skilled for the level they are working at. Because I am a rider myself first and foremost, I know that every horse is an individual and no single approach works for everyone. I am a flexible trainer who can work with all types of riders and horses to help them reach their goals."

This clinic will be two lessons over two days, in flat work, jumping, and dressage, in groups of up to four. Please include with your signup some information about the level you and your horse are riding so you can be put in an appropriate group. Also, note if you would like flat/dressage only lessons without jumping. Cost is \$180 for each 2-day clinic, or \$340 if you do both clinics. Refunds: in full up to ten days prior to clinic (1/17 and 3/1), later than 10 days out no refund unless space can be filled.

Releasor understands there are risks in equine activities: that all horse activities are inherently dangerous, and agrees to comply with Oregon's Equine Inherent Risk Law ORS.30.687-30.697, which limits liability for providers of equine activities and services. As a condition of participation in or viewing equine activities, Releasor (individually and for his/her minor children, executors and heirs) waives the right to bring and releases Releasee and Releasee's administrators, agents, officers, directors, employees, contractors predecessors and successors-in-interest, and any other persons or entities united in interest with Releasee from any and all manner of actions, suits, claims for relief, demands, damages, and any other obligations, known and unknown, suspected and unsuspected, in law of equity, direct or indirect and whether now or in the future, for any injury or death arising out of or connected in any way with riding, training, grooming, or handling and equine. Releasor agrees that by using the Inavale Farm facility, including barns and arenas, trails, jumps, tack and horses, he/she is participating in a dangerous sport and that he/she will be responsible for the safety of self and children or others in their party. Releasor understands that Inavale Farm requires safety helmets and boots with heels to be worn by all riders under 18, all students while participating in lessons, all riders while jumping, and strongly recommends that all riders wear helmets and boots at all times. This release contains the entire agreement between the two parties hereto and the terms of this release are contractual, not a mere recital. I have read and understand and agree to this release.
